NO SMOKING POLICY



NO SMOKING

From 1st July 2007, all public places and workplaces have become smoke-free in England, with the exception of a limited number of exemptions under the Smoke-free (Premises and Enforcement) Regulations 2006.

Children's health and well being is of the utmost importance for the out of school club.

Smoking

has been proven to be a health risk and therefore in accordance with childcare Legislation, the club operates a strict no smoking policy within it's buildings and grounds.

Parents and carers are respectfully required to abstain from smoking whilst on the premises. This rule also applies to staff, students, visitors and contractors.

Staffs accompanying children outside the out of school club are NOT permitted to smoke
