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## Play Policy

The Parachute club aims to provide a wide varied range of activities to meet the needs of all children to encourage them to develop their emotional, social and physical skills.

Activities, visits and outings will be carefully planned allowing children to create and explore, whilst learning and achieving.

Children will always be consulted and encouraged to take part in the preparation and planning of all activities and outings, staff will be encouraged to support and involve children and recognise any child's achievements.

The club will provide a range of structured activities, equipment and resources to meet the needs, age and interests of all children. Children will be offered outdoor play unless weather or health and safety issues prevent this.

All activity planning will be available at all times for staff, children and parents to view. Staff will always be available to discuss and spend time with parents, to inform them as to what their child has been doing and discuss any changes they would like to see made.

For children in the early year's section at school, a learning and development journal and a key worker will be assigned; parents will be asked to review the journal every 3 months.
